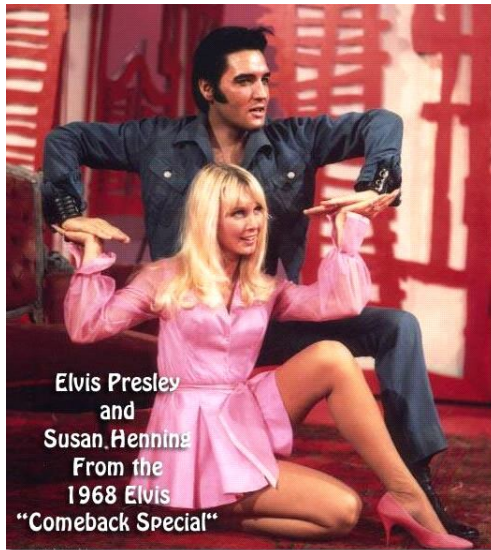


# CATCH ELVIS BEFORE HE'S GONE

The Elvis *Return to Sender* weekend, starting at 11 a.m. on June 26 at the Petaluma Museum, 20 4<sup>th</sup> St. in Historic Downtown Petaluma, offers fans one more chance to catch the spirit of the “Elvis! Grace and Grit” exhibit before the “King of Rock ‘n Roll” leaves the building.



Some special Elvis fans, including former 1965 Miss Teen USA, Susan Henning will be on hand to say so long to the exhibition aimed at providing visitors with a look at a major piece of the history of American pop culture. Ms. Henning appeared in the Elvis film *Live a Little, Love a Little* and on the 1968 *Comeback Special*. She will be selling copies of her book “68” and her pictures with Elvis in the Museum from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Artist Dominic Giglio, on hand to sign and sell a limited number of the collectable lithographs from an edition completed 36-years ago, offers a great story of how he came to be under contract to produce promotional art for the “King” in the 1970s. Signing takes place from 1 to 3 p.m.



As a grand finale noted Elvis impersonator, Rick Torres, performs at 6 p.m. from
