Other appearances include *"Carmina Burana,"* *"Serenade to Music,"* *"Misa Criolla,"* *"Exultate Jubilate,"* and the world premiere of Nielsen's *"Out of Africa"* with organizations such as Symphony Silicon

Valley, Sierra Symphony, South Valley Symphony, American Philharmonic, and Ballet San Jose.
